## Quick-Start Guide to the Sennheiser In-Ear Monitoring System

Your Sennheiser In-Ear Monitoring system is designed to provide one stereo or two mono personal audio feeds, and each receiver can either hear the stereo mix (“Stereo” mode) or a balance of the two mono mixes (“Focus” mode), as required.

The mains-powered transmitter will be configured to your requirements before you receive it, and therefore you should not need to do anything further with this.

You should position the transmitter so that it has a clear, uninterrupted line of sight to your performers.

To switch on your battery-powered receiver, turn the volume knob on the top. **Caution: turn up the volume gently to help prevent damage to your hearing from audio sources which are too loud.**

In “Stereo” mode you will hear the full stereo mix without the opportunity to pan the audio from one side to the other.

In “Focus” mode each receiver can choose a balance between the left and right channels by pressing the ▲ and ▼ arrows on the front of the receiver. The display will show the balance, ranging from “L15” (*only listen to the audio on the left-hand side*) to “L=R” (*listen to both sides equally*), to “R15” (*only listen to the audio on the right-hand side*). Note: despite using the labels “Left” and “Right”, in Focus mode you will hear your selected balance as a mono audio mix at the same level in both ears.

If you have hired IE4 earphone from us then we will have supplied each pair with three sizes of detachable earbuds - small, medium and large - to provide the best fit for your ears. For hygiene reasons the earbuds are disposable, and at the end of your hire you only need to return the earphones.
